NP.50.70.110 – Annex Scope of Licensing of Content for Mobile Apps

This Annex supplements the "GPC IT - Part K - Licensing of Content for Mobile Apps" and describes the licensed Content, its provision and availability as well as any restrictions on the scope of licensing.

1. Licensed Content

Exact designation of the licensed Content:

The licensed Content shall be updated on an ongoing basis during the term of the order and any transition period, at least as is customary for the Contractor in relation to other customers at the date of the order.

□ No continuous updating of the licensed content

The technical performance specification designated in the Customer's order shall apply without any commercial or legal components (hereinafter "technical performance specification"). Details are to be specified in the technical performance specification.

2. Provision of Content for Retrieval and Availability (with Service Levels, as applicable).

The Contractor shall keep licensed Content continuously available online for retrieval by the Customer, including any group company, as well as users of mobile apps, unless otherwise expressly stipulated in the technical performance description.

Details as well as any restrictions and service levels shall be specified in the technical performance description.

3. Scope of Licensing (Tick as appropriate below)

- 3.1 Time limit:

□ The re-provision and availability of the licensed Content shall commence upon conclusion of the Contract and end on
